STABLING:

Permanent 10 X 10 stalls, with sliding doors, in center-aisle barns. Barns have hot water wash racks, modern bathrooms with showers, vending areas. Facility staff will remove center partitions for horse double stalls (\$220 rate for weekend) if ordered by closing date (limited, first come first served, may be declined and price difference refunded). Indicate on entry form. Bedding included: 2 bales per Horse stall, 4 bales per Double Stall, 0 bales per Tack stall. Stallion owners must purchase tack stall as buffer. Extra bedding may be ordered in advance (\$8) or purchased on grounds (\$10). Note: **facility rules prohibit the use of outside bedding.** Contact mgr. for special needs.

CAMPING

Full hookups, plus dump station, on grounds near stabling. Indicate rig length and breaker amp (20, 30, 50 amps available) on entry form. Golf carts available for rent, email manager for details.

DIRECTIONS:

GPS Address: 2630 Prison Camp Road, Williamston N.C. 27892

Martin Ag Center is located just off NC 64 in Williamston, NC. (48 miles east of I-95). From NC 64, take exit 512. Turn South, SBM Ag Center is 100 yards on right.

TRAILERS: Barns A-D: Drive past main entrance, turn right on Allen Williams Road (less than ¼ mi.) for direct stabling access. Barns E-F use main entrance, keep right around coliseum. After unloading, empty trailers park in designated places only. (Exception: Campers)

ARENAS:

Competition: Two indoor, five outdoor, all 20 X 60 m.

Warmup: One indoor, two covered, four outdoor, grass and permanent round pens for lunging. All outdoor rings are sand/stone all-weather footing. Indoor rings are sand / clay composite footing, with coliseum seating for 2,000 spectators.

Coliseum open for schooling Thursday until 8 p.m. Friday p.m. schooling hours: TBA, check website.

HOSPITALITY:

Competitor's Party Saturday evening. Complimentary Starbucks coffee bar for competitors.

Food concessions in coliseum, indoor and outdoor vendor space available, contact manager.

OTHER:

Entries accepted on a first come basis by postmark/datestamp. Management reserves the right to combine or divide classes, add or substitute judges, or make changes as required by circumstances.

All dogs must be leashed, no dogs allowed in coliseum. **State facility requires all horses post extra coggins in sleeve on stall door.**

ENTRY DOCUMENTATION REQUIREMENTS

- Current USEF membership (or n/m fees) for Rider, Owner and Trainer, Coach
- Current USDF membership (or n/m fees, number) for Rider and Owner. **Rider's USDF membership may be either Participating or Group, Owner's USDF membership may be Participating, Group or Business; if Rider/Owner's USDF # is a nonmember ID #, the USDF n/m fee must be paid.**
- USDF Horse ID.
- Current (1 Yr) negative coggins.
- For Adult Amateur classes - USEF membership card must declare Amateur, or include \$30 amateur non-member declaration fee.
- Juniors and Young Riders must include birthdate.
- Freestyle entries - copy of a 60% + at the highest test of the MFS level or higher (exempt: FEI Jr /Yr/ Pony and Para).
- **FOR GAIG / USDF QUALIFYING CLASSES ALSO INCLUDE:**
- Check "Qualifying" and add \$10 per Qualifying class.
- Copies of USEF and USDF Horse Registrations (not HID #s).
- Rider must have current Participating USDF membership; Owner must have current Participating or Business USDF membership.
- Rider, Owner, Trainer and Coach must have current USEF membership.

ALL ENTRIES must have THREE signatures - Rider, Owner and Trainer.

Legal Guardian must sign for riders under 18 yrs. Trainer blank must be signed by person over 18 who assumes responsibility for horse. (Parents who sign as trainer are exempt from membership requirements). See www.usdf.org and www.usef.org and/or USEF Rule Book for further details on entry requirements.

FOR ANY DRESSAGE SHOW HELD WITH THE SERVICES OF EQUESTRIAN SECRETARIAL SERVICES:

Ensure that all (rider/handler, owner, trainer, horse, coach) USDF and USEF memberships and registrations are **complete and current** in the respective on-line databases, enter all numbers accurately on your entry form, and SEND NO DOCUMENTATION WHATSOEVER.

If your memberships and/or registrations are **not** current in the USDF and USEF on-line databases, send documentation proof with your "first of the year" entry. For each subsequent entry *in the competition year*, SEND NO DOCUMENTATION WHATSOEVER.

Be SURE to include a CURRENT and LEGIBLE email address with your entry! Equestrian Secretarial Services will check your memberships and registrations on-line with both USEF and USDF. If you are lacking, you will receive notification via email. Coggins and signatures (3) are still required for each entry.

ON-LINE ENTRIES:

Visit www.EquestrianSecretarialServices.com or link from www.SportingServices.net to enter on-line and pay via PayPal / major credit card - OR Print and Mail with your check. You do NOT need a PayPal account to use this service! You will choose the show you wish to enter and will be required to enter the class number(s) you wish to ride and the stabling you need. Your fees will be totaled automatically. You will click the "Pay via PayPal" button to pay for your entry. (or Print and Mail with check). You will have the opportunity to print your completed entry for your records and will receive an automated email receipt. **You will be required to submit your negative coggins (and, if applicable, your MFS documentation) at check-in. You will also be required to provide all signatures (rider, owner, trainer and – if applicable – parent or legal guardian and coach) at check-in. Your coggins may be uploaded; you may sign electronically.**
