CLASSES SPLIT IF ENTRIES WARRANT: Open, Junior (list birthdate), Young Rider (list birthdate), Adult Amateur (USEF membership must state amateur).

BLM: Bengt Ljungquist Memorial Championships qualifying class. Visit www.cblm.org for details.

GAIG/USDF-Q: Great American Insurance Group/USDF Qualifying class, state qualifying and add \$10 to fee.

AQHA APPROVED: Heads up Quarter Horses!! Scores of 60% + can earn AQHA points for your horse at this show. To be eligible, horse and rider must meet all AQHA and USDF www.USDF.org membership requirements and the horse must be AQHA registered, have current AQHA papers, and have an AQHA Lifetime Dressage Competition License (nomination form available at: http://www.aqha.com/forms/pdf/AQHA_Dressage_Nomination.pdf).

TOC: Test of Choice, state test on entry form. MFS entrants must also submit copy of 60%+ ride in highest test of level, or higher.

LEVELS: USDF Intro - FEI Grand Prix, all current editions. All rings 20 X 60 m. including Para-Equestrian.

Intro, Materiale, Opportunity, Exhibition, and Equitation: \$35.00

(note: Intro, Opportunity, and Exhibition classes exempt from all horse ID and membership requirements. Opportunity and Exhibition classes also exempt from USEF \$16 fee.

Guest horses - *(non-competing)* Welcomed! Submit signed entry form, coggins, pay \$20 office fee plus either stabling or day parking, as applicable. No late fees charged on guest horses.

Checks: payable to **Sporting Services**. Waive signature requirements on express mail.

Refunds: Before closing date, less office fee. No refunds after closing date.

Bounced checks: \$25 penalty.

ONLINE ENTRY: pay with major credit card or mail with check – NO EXTRA FEES!

Smart Entry Refund: Complete entries submitted Aug 12-19 receive \$20 cash refund at check-in. (scratches void).

Extra Bedding: Order and pre-pay \$8 per bale, or bring your own. No bedding sales at show.

AWARDS:

- Trophy, custom screen printed towels through fifth in all classes (ribbons optional).
- Gold, silver, bronze medals and special prizes for Dressage Seat Equitation.

\$300 Sotheby's Stakes (Classes 211, 221, 231, 241, 250-251, 252-253) *Sponsored by McDevitt Sotheby's International Realty. Winner: \$150, trophy. Second: \$100, third, \$50. (Footnote 1): Classes 250 and 251 comprise the \$250 Sotheby's Small Tour Stakes: Classes ranked and pinned separately, but combined for prize money. (Footnote 2): Classes 252 and 253, comprise the \$250 Sotheby's Large Tour Stakes. Classes ranked and pinned separately, but combined for prize money.*

Highest combined scores of McDevitt Sotheby MFS class AND a Sotheby Stakes class at three of four participating shows will determine the champion. Winner take all, prize awarded at NCDCTA Harvest Moon November 2012. Participating shows: March Magic Dressage, Dressage at Lexington, Pinehurst Fall Dressage, and NCDCTA Harvest Moon. If participating in all four shows, best three count.*

STABLING:

Permanent stalls with doors or screens, in center-aisle barns. Stallion owners please purchase tack stall as buffer. Initial bedding included in stabling fee: Horse stall: 2 bales, Tack stall 0. **Order and prepay for extra bedding in advance, or bring your own. Note # of bales on form, pay \$8 per. No bedding sales at show.**

TIMES:

Official times available Friday at show office. Unofficial times posted www.SportingServices.net. Entry acknowledgement via email. Include LEGIBLE email address on entry form. **Riders assume responsibility for checking online entry and stabling status on/before closing date to verify correct information; mgmt. not responsible for errors, omissions.**

DIRECTIONS:

GPS Address: 200 Beulah Hill Rd. S. Pinehurst NC 28374.

Pinehurst Harness Track is located on N.C. 5 in Pinehurst, N.C. *From North:* US 1 South, exit at Morganton Road in Southern Pines, turn west (right) toward Pinehurst. Follow Morganton to end, turn South (left) on NC 5. Harness Track entrance is first left. *From the West,* take US 220 (I 73/74 corridor) to NC 211 east towards Pinehurst. Turn right at NC 5, Harness Track is 1.7 miles on left. Watch 35 mph speed limit here, Pinehurst police are vigilant! *From South:* US 1 to Aberdeen, turn left (West) on NC 5 to Harness Track, entrance approx. 6 miles on right, just beyond stoplight at Monticello Rd.

ARENAS:

Four 20 X 60 competition arenas on all-weather sand / stone dust footing. Warm up is acres of irrigated, aerated, turf with natural sand base. Three time USDF Region One Footing of the Year award winner.

HOSPITALITY:

Wine and cheese party Saturday evening, food concessions and Track Restaurant (open 6am-1pm) on grounds. Vendors welcomed, see website for details. Resort restaurants, shopping, over 50 golf courses, Call Visitors Bureau for details (910) 692-3330.

OTHER:

"Busiest Trainer" (brings the most horses and students) wins free golf cart rental for weekend. Management reserves the right to add or divide classes, add or substitute judges, or make any changes as required by circumstances. Entries accepted on first come basis, by postmark /datestamp. ENTRY DOCUMENTATION REQUIREMENTS

- Current USEF membership (or n/m fees) for Rider, Owner and Trainer, Coach
- Current USDF membership (or n/m fees, number) for Rider and Owner. **Rider's USDF membership may be either Participating or Group, Owner's USDF membership may be Participating, Group or Business; if Rider/Owner's USDF # is a nonmember ID #, the USDF n/m fee must be paid.**
- USDF Horse ID.
- Current (1 Yr) negative coggins.
- For Adult Amateur classes - USEF membership card must declare Amateur, or include \$30 amateur non-member declaration fee.
- Juniors and Young Riders must include birthdate.
- Freestyle entries - copy of a 60% + at the highest test of the MFS level or higher (exempt: FEI Jr /Yr/ Pony and Para).
- **FOR GAIG / USDF QUALIFYING CLASSES ALSO INCLUDE:**
- Check "Qualifying" and add \$10 per Qualifying class.
- Copies of USEF and USDF Horse Registrations (not HID #s).
- Rider must have current Participating USDF membership; Owner must have current Participating or Business USDF membership.
- Rider, Owner, Trainer and Coach must have current USEF membership.

ALL ENTRIES must have THREE signatures - Rider, Owner and Trainer.

Legal Guardian must sign for riders under 18 yrs. Trainer blank must be signed by person over 18 who assumes responsibility for horse. (Parents who sign as trainer are exempt from membership requirements). See www.usdf.org and www.usef.org and/or USEF Rule Book for further details on entry requirements.

FOR ANY DRESSAGE SHOW HELD WITH THE SERVICES OF EQUESTRIAN SECRETARIAL SERVICES:

Ensure that all (rider/handler, owner, trainer, horse, coach) USDF and USEF memberships and registrations are **complete and current** in the respective on-line databases, enter all numbers accurately on your entry form, and SEND NO DOCUMENTATION WHATSOEVER.

If your memberships and/or registrations are **not** current in the USDF and USEF on-line databases, send documentation proof with your "first of the year" entry. For each subsequent entry *in the competition year*, SEND NO DOCUMENTATION WHATSOEVER.

Be SURE to include a CURRENT and LEGIBLE email address with your entry! Equestrian Secretarial Services will check your memberships and registrations on-line with both USEF and USDF. If you are lacking, you will receive notification via email. Coggins and signatures (3) are still required for each entry.

ON-LINE ENTRIES:

Visit www.EquestrianSecretarialServices.com or link from www.SportingServices.net to enter on-line and pay via PayPal / major credit card - OR Print and Mail with your check. You do NOT need a PayPal account to use this service! You will choose the show you wish to enter and will be required to enter the class number(s) you wish to ride and the stabling you need. Your fees will be totaled automatically. You will click the "Pay via PayPal" button to pay for your entry. (or Print and Mail with check). You will have the opportunity to print your completed entry for your records and will receive an automated email receipt. **You will be required to submit your negative coggins (and, if applicable, your MFS documentation) at check-in. You will also be required to provide all signatures (rider, owner, trainer and – if applicable – parent or legal guardian and coach) at check-in. Your coggins may be uploaded; you may sign electronically.**
